RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Students should be punctual to college. The college timings are from 9.45 am to 4.15 pm. Students will not be allowed to enter the class if they are late by more than 5 minutes.
2. All the students should attend classes regularly and are expected to put in not less than 80% of attendance in both theory & practicals as per University regulations.
3. Students who fail to put in the minimum attendance will not be permitted to take up the Examination.
4. Applications for leave should be submitted to the Principal duly signed through the respective class-in-charge.
5. Students should take up all the sessionals without absenting themselves.
6. Ragging in any form will lead to expulsion of the student from the college as per act of the Government of Tamilnadu and various pronouncements of the Supreme Court.
7. Students in inebriated condition or under the influence of intoxicating drugs will be severely dealt with as per Government Rules.
8. Students are expected to read notices and circulars put up on the college notice board. Ignorance of any notice thus displayed will not be accepted as an excuse for failing to comply with the same.
9. **Dress Code**
Boys: Formal pants with full sleeve or half sleeve shirt neatly tucked in. Black shoes with socks. No slippers will be allowed. No jeans and T shirts will be allowed. Should be neatly shaved with trim haircut.
Girls: Salwar Kameez /kurti. No Jeans and T shirts will be allowed.



10. IDENTITY CARD

The Identity card will be issued by the college office which should be worn while in the campus. If the identity card is lost, a duplicate card will be issued on the payment of Rs.100/- along with a passport size photo.

11. FEES REGULATIONS

The tuition fees has to be remitted before as DD in favor of C.L.BAID METHA COLLEGE OF PHARMACY payable at Chennai. If the tuition fees is not paid on or before the due date a fine will be levied.

12. D.PHARM ORIGINAL CERTIFICATE

After passing the final examination and completing 500 hours of practical training, the students shall apply for the issue of original certificate along with the demand draft, the original practical training certificate, photocopies of plus two/intermediate certificates, Diploma exam mark sheets and practical training certificate at the college office in person. This will be forwarded to the Board of Pharmacy, Directorate of Medical Education for the issue of the original certificate.

13. SCHOLARSHIP

The college office will process the SC/ST scholarship as per the norms of Government of Tamilnadu. Students should contact the



college office will all relevant documents on time as announce in the notice board.

14. LIBRARY

(i) The Library will remain open from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm on all working days.

(i) Students identity card will be used as Library card.

(ii) Students are expected to use the books with care. Markings in books, tearing of pages are prohibited. A fine of double the cost of the book will be charged if any damage to the books is noticed.

(iii) LOSS OF BOOKS: Loss of books shall be reported to the librarian immediately. If the borrowers are unable to replace the book, the cost of the book will be recovered.

(iv) Duration of loan and overdue charges: Students can retain a book for a week only. If the due falls on a holiday he/she should return it on the next working day. Overdue charges is Rs.5 per day.

(v) A book may be re-issued for another week to a student at his/her request, provided it is produced before the librarian and if there is no demand for it at the time of re-issue.

(vi) The librarian can recall the book at any time without giving any reason

(vii) Students are not allowed to lend the books taken from the library to other students

(viii) Strict silence must be observed at all times in the library

(ix) No magazine or newspaper should be taken out of the library

(x) Internet facilities can be utilized by all students
